

Minutes of the Jan 17, 2017 meeting of the Rockland Preserve Management Committee

Members Present: Joe Oslander, Dave Okamoto, Jason Engelhardt, Rich Nace

Meeting was called to order at 7.45 PM.

Minutes: The minutes from the November 2016 meeting were accepted as submitted.

1. RWA has agreed to install a gate in front of the log cabin house at the North Gate. Plans are underway to install 2 or 3 gates for passage by the residents and into the preserve.
2. Rte 79 lot projects are at a standstill for the winter. The millings are hardened, so they will wait for the Spring for another road project to accumulate more surface to finish the lot project. Stumps need to be removed.
3. Met with Scot Erskine about installing a pump track at the Rte 79 lot to be part of the budgeted playground money in the Capital Projects Fund for 2017-2018.
 - There is gravel on the old Whitney Pond Road, there are mounds of dirt by Coan Pond, is it possible to utilize the dirt in those mounds for the pump track?
4. Finish Signage for rescue plans and coordinate with fire department realignment of yellow and red trails to ease navigation and align with maps
5. Singletracks
 - Recognition sign ordered and paid for by NEMBA
 - Tim's trail is complete, needs some pruning
6. Projects and Goals for 2017 reviewed by Joe Oslander and priorities assigned. Separate memo submitted by Joe Oslander
