- Town Fields Update – Scott
 - Base paths have been rolled out and bases have been placed.
 - Turface has been placed on Town Campus and JC Aux
 - Mats will be removed shortly once the weather improves, fields remain closed
 - The bullpen at Polson will need to be re-worked due to the height difference with home plate and pitching mound
 - Field lining at exchange soccer with a change in paint vender
 - UCONN study continues on Jansen fields but may cause uneven surface due to lack of water
 - Potential issue with the lock at Polson softball, communications have been sent to Hand AD.
 - Polson softball batting cage will get left over turf from Strong Field
