BOARD OF SELECTMEN PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

7:15 p.m. Public Hearing

First Selectman Banisch called the Public Hearing of Monday, March 27, 2017 to order at 7:17 p.m. Present were First Selectman Banisch, Selectman Goldberg, Selectman Hale, Selectman Murphy, and Selectman Wilson. The purpose of the Public Hearing was to hear comment on the 2017 Small Cities Community Development Program Application process for Concord Meadows Retirement Community.

Larry Wagner, a consultant for the Concord Meadows property stated that the project encompassed a grant application totaling \$800,000 to replace windows and update bathrooms at the Concord Meadows site. The Town receives the grant directly from the state and the property is responsible for ensuring that the project is completed and they submit invoices to the Town for payment.

There being no objections, First Selectman Banisch adjourned to the Regular Meeting of the Board of Selectmen at 7:19 p.m.
