At a meeting held on October 3, 2013, the Commission took the following action:

2013 Plan of Conservation & Development. Applicant: Madison Planning & Zoning Commission. Discussion and possible adoption of the 2013 Plan of Conservation and Development. **Adopted, effective November 9, 2013.**

13-28. Regulation Amendment. Applicant: Madison Planning & Zoning Commission. The proposal of the Madison Planning & Zoning Commission to establish a nine (9) month Moratorium consisting of the following:

By Amending Section 2, General Requirements, by adding a new paragraph 2.20.3 Medical Marijuana Dispensaries and Producers: The Madison Planning & Zoning Commission shall not accept or consider any application to permit the establishment of Medical Marijuana Producers and Dispensary Facilities for a period of nine (9) months commencing from the effective date of October 11, 2013. The reason for this moratorium is to allow the Planning & Zoning Commission to review the "*State of Connecticut Regulation of the Department of Consumer Protection concerning Palliative Use of Marijuana*" and the associated application process for producers and dispensary facilities and to draft and/or adopt municipal regulations regarding the production and distribution of medical marijuana within the Town of Madison. The expiration date of said Moratorium will be July 11, 2014 unless extended by the Planning & Zoning Commission. **Approved.**
