## **BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES**

### **Emergency Session**

Selectman Murphy called the Emergency Session of Monday, August 10, 2020 to order at 2:34 p.m. Also in attendance were Selectwoman Duques, Selectman Goldberg and Selectman Wilson; Emergency Management Director Sam DeBurra, Public Works Director John Iennaco, Town Services Coordinator / Risk Manager Lauren Rhines.

1. Discuss response to Tropical Storm Isaias.

Emergency Management Director Sam DeBurra provided an overview of Eversource's work within the town this morning. The Board reviewed that there were only currently 266 outages in town and also reviewed the meetings and reviews that should occur after the storm is cleaned up.

The Board asked if there were any issues with the response from Eversource as a result of the COVID pandemic and Mr. DeBurra stated that he could not confirm this.

The Board also reviewed that plans for the Primary may be impacted if Brown School does not have power restored by 10:00 p.m. tonight. Also, Mr. Iennaco reviewed the debris removal process which will continue.

Selectman Goldberg and Selectman Murphy provided a brief update on Senator Blumenthal's visit to Madison this morning which was taped and will be broadcast on evening news stations.
