1) "SHALL THE TOWN OF MADISON APPROPRIATE \$34,284,000 FOR DEMOLITION OF THE EXISTING RYERSON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, FURNISHING AND EQUIPPING OF A NEW KINDERGARTEN THROUGH THIRD GRADE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ON THE SAME PARCEL AS THE EXISTING SCHOOL, AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND NOTES IN AN AMOUNT SUFFICIENT TO FINANCE THE PORTION OF THE APPROPRIATION NOT DEFRAID FROM GRANTS (AN ANTICIPATED NET PROJECT COST OF BETWEEN \$28,584,000 AND \$30,284,000)?"
